

## **RENEWAL OF MEMBERSHIP**

Dear Member

Please find below details of the membership structure and fees for 2013/14 and the renewal process.

Full membership for Wigan Swimming club gives the swimmer the opportunity to swim 3 times each week on Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Sunday depending on their allocated group. This type of membership for 2013/2014 will cost £276 payable in full during October 2013 or by monthly instalments of £23.00. Discount will apply for 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> children.

Other membership types are also available including 1 swim and 2 swim for those swimmers who are in either Age Group Development or Age Group Performance of Wigan Swim Squad. Junior Development swimmers are not eligible for the 1 swim/2 swim membership. The 1 session swim fee is £132.00 (£11.00 per month) or 2 session swim £216.00 (£18.00 per month). For those opting for this membership type the following sessions are available;

1 swim – Wednesday session only (1.5 hours)

1 swim – Wednesday session plus one more session on any day

For those aged 16 and above on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2013 the club has a Masters membership which is a 1 swim membership (Monday session). The fee structure for this membership has altered slightly for the 2013/2014 year;

Annual payment is £102.00

Monthly payment is £9.00

Pay per swim is £4.00 per session.

The one off annual fee is £35.00 for the Regional no swim membership and £20.00 for the National no swim membership. Regional no swim membership is only available to those Swim Squad swimmers who will be aged 13 or above during the club year (1<sup>st</sup> October 2013 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2014).

**All those wishing to renew their membership are required to take the following action:**

1. Speak to Janine King, the membership secretary, during the first week of October regarding membership renewal. Janine will issue you with a renewal slip detailing the information you will need in order to complete the online registration process. This will include the website details, reference, ASA Category, method of pay and sibling discount. If you are paying monthly you will be issued with a standing order form which must be returned to Janine by 22<sup>nd</sup> October.
2. Register your child online by 15<sup>th</sup> October 2013. You must answer all the questions and provide all the information regarding medical history.
3. You will then receive an email advising you of your initial payment. This will be the full membership fee or one month's fee for October if you are paying monthly. The club also requires payment of the ASA fee at this time. This varies depending on the swimmer's ASA Category.

ASA Category 1 – WSC swimmers who are aged 8 or under on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2014 or WSC swimmers aged 13 and over who have not been selected for the Arena League team or do not compete in open competitions..

ASA Category 2 – WSC swimmers who are aged 9 to 12 years on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2014 or any swimmer who competes in open competition.

ASA Category 3 – Committee, coaches and helpers.

The initial payment can be made in cash or by cheque made payable to Wigan Swimming Club. This payment must be given to Janine by 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2013 together with a completed standing order form.

4. Once the completed standing order form and payment have been given to Janine the membership for 2013/2014 will be processed and the standing order form sent to your bank.

Anyone wishing to set up a standing order via internet banking will need to speak to Janine before doing so.

With a current membership of 145 it is important for all members to renew and adhere to the above dates in order for the standing orders to be processed by the banks in time for November's payment.
