## Promoter's Conditions, Percy Mason Memorial Meet Saturday $30^{\text {th }}$ November and Sunday $1^{\text {st }}$ December 2019

1. The competition will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming.
2. The Licence number for the meet is 3NW192516
3. The competition will be held at Orford Jubilee Neighbourhood Hub, Jubilee Way, Orford, Warrington, Cheshire, WA2 8HE.
4. Entries for this meet will be on a 'first come, first served' basis. The Promoter reserves the right to close entries earlier than the stated date, if the meet is becoming over-subscribed.
5. The closing date for submitted entries is midnight on Sunday $13^{\text {th }}$ October 2019
6. All ages are 'age on day' as of midnight 1st December 2019.
7. The pool is 25 m 8 - lane with anti-wave lane ropes and electronic timing.
8. Age groups for boys and girls are $9,10,11,12,13,14,15$ and over.
9. Start times are as stated in the programme of events but may be subject to change. Any changes will be notified on the club website.
10. Over the top starts will be used and all events will be heat declared winners.
11. Entries and results for this meet will be held on computer and may be published before, during or after the meet. As required by the General Data Protection Regulation 2018, permission to hold and use such personal data will be deemed to have been given by the submission of an entry.
12. Warm up times will be split at the Promoter's discretion. All clubs will be required to provide supervision during the warm up for their own swimmers.
13. Anybody wishing to use photography equipment must register at the payment desk where they will be issued with a pass which must be worn at all times.
14. Spectator admission will be $£ 8$ per day, under 16 's will be admitted free of charge. Spectators only staying for 1 session will receive a $£ 4$ refund on surrender of the wristband which all spectators will be required to wear. A programme to cover the whole of the meet will cost $£ 2$. All heats/results will be available on Meet Mobile and possibly via the Live Results link on the website home page on the day of the meet, shortly before the start time.
15. All results displayed on the electronic scoreboard are for indication only and may not be the official result.
16. Medals will be presented to the top 6 winners in each age group. Awards will also be presented to the top point scoring girl and boy and top visiting club.
17. Entries -_will be accepted from any swimmer registered with an ASA affiliated club. The minimum age for entry will be 9 years as of midnight on 1st December 2019. There are no qualifying times, swimmers with no times may enter this meet. However, all entries should have a coach's estimate for the purpose of seeding. No swimmer should have exceeded or equalled the upper limit times as stated in the entry pack.
18. The Promoter reserves the right to restrict entries in the interests of safety, time constraints and to ensure the smooth running of the competition.
19. Where it becomes necessary to restrict the number of entries, the following criteria will be used

- Priority will be given to swimmers who are accompanied by a visiting official. Names and qualifications of officials willing to attend must be provided at the time of entry to qualify for priority
- Swimmers with fastest submitted times will take precedence in each age group
