FACILITIES 8 Lane (2 ½ m wide) 25m Pool using Colorado System 6 Electronic Timing. The spectator balcony holds 250 people with an additional comfort gallery overlooking the pool.

AGE As the last day of the competition, Sunday 17th November 2019.

THE MEET Events include 50m, 100m, 200m on all strokes, 100m, 200m, 400m individual medley, 400m, 800m(girls), 1500m(boys) freestyle. Entries will be seeded on a slowest to fastest basis and accepted on a maximum number per single age group i.e. 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs & over, please see consideration times. Age groups apply to all events, except 100m, 800m & 1500m events where there is no 9 years. All events are heat declared winner.

Please read the consideration times carefully and make sure your entry time is faster than the times. Anything slower will NOT be considered. Swimmers must be 9 years or over on the day.

Entry times should be must be British rankings database and if 50m (long course) times are used these should be converted to 25m (short course) using the Equivalent Performance Tables or the Sportsystem Equivalent Times Converter electronic programme. Entry times will be checked by the promoters.

Conditions

1. The Competition will be held under Swim England Law & FINA technical rules.
2. One start rule will apply. Over the top starts may be used at the organiser's discretion.
3. The pool is 25m long, 8 lanes, each lane is 2 ½ m wide and the pool uses anti wave lane ropes and electronic timing.
4. All events will be Heat Declared Winners.
5. The Referees decision is final.
6. This meet will be run using SportSystems software.
7. Late or poolside entries will not be accepted.
8. Time enteries to be based on 25m (short course)pool times. 50m (long course)times must be converted using British Swimming / Sport Systems conversion method.
9. The minimum age is 9, to comply with Swim England rule 411.5.3
10. Confirmation of entry will be posted on the website and emailed to the respective clubs along with any rejections and information on how to withdraw. No further information will be returned.
11. Entry for spectators is £10 per day, refund of £4.00 if you return you wristband before the start of the afternoon session. Friday's long distance events is £2.
12. Spectators programmes are available after entry.
13. In the case of events that are over subscribed, refunds will be issued for those events only.
14. Withdrawals must be made before the start of the warm up, of each session.
15. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.
16. Footwear must be worn outside the pool area.
17. The small pool will be available for continuous warm up and cool down, however, in the event of mis-use of this facility, Wigan Life Centre reserve the right to close it at any time, without warning.
18. Coaches, team managers and poolside assistances must display their passes at all times.
19. Starts sheets will be available to pass holders only and will not be on sale to swimmers or spectators.
20. The director reserves the right to limit entries.
21. The Meet Director / promoters will reserve the right to amend the programme / warm up/start times depending upon numbers of entries received, or for any other reason.
22. Entery Summery must be completed for both electronic and paper enteries and and returned with one cheque to cover all entries.
23. Any point not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the organisers.
