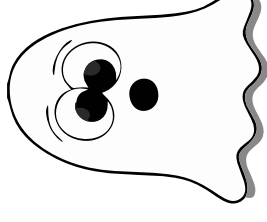


1. General Conditions

- 1.1 Halloween Sprint Meet shall be run in accordance with ASA Laws and Technical Rules.
- 1.2 This competition is licensed at Level 3, license no: Applied For
- 1.3 Entries will be accepted from any Swim England affiliated swimmer.
- 1.4 The competition shall include the following age groups for each sex:
9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 , 15 years and over
- 1.5 Upper limit times apply for entry to this event and are shown on page 6 of these conditions, entries from swimmers without times will be accepted and will be seeded automatically by the SportSystem software.
- 1.6 Qualifying times can be achieved at a level 1, 2, 3 4 or 'Level X' licensed meet.
- 1.7 All events will be swum as 'Heat Declared Winner' in mixed age groups, seeded by entry time.
- 1.8 All heats shall be spearheaded.
- 1.9 Age Groups will be separated for results and awards purposes.
- 1.10 Results will be published in time order.
- 1.11 The entry fee will be £4.25 per event for electronic entries using SportSystems entry file, Paper entries will charged at £5.00 per event.
- 1.12 Closing date for entries shall be Monday 4th October 2021 or when the meet is full. Events with fewer than 3 total entries in either boys/girls category will be removed from the programme. Entries should be received along with fees to the competition organiser by the closing date. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Organiser. Poolside, or improved entries will not be accepted.
- 1.13 In the event of any session being oversubscribed, swimmer numbers will be reduced by rejecting entries from the fastest swimmers of each age group from events selected at the discretion of the Competition Organiser.



1.14 Refunds will only be given:

Where entrants are denied entry because the number of entries has been restricted in the interest of safety or to ensure the smooth running of the competition. Where a competitor has to withdraw on proven medical grounds.

1.15 Age on the day will be as of October 30th 2021.

1.16 Any matters not covered in these conditions or any supplementary information will be at the discretion of the Competition Organiser.

1.20 By entering the gala, each parent/swimmer agrees that the following data will be held on the clubs meet management software and after the event the data along with results will be submitted to British Rankings.
(Family Name, Given Name, Date of Birth, Age, ASA Number, Club)

2. Awards

2.1 Medals will be awarded to the first 3 swimmers in each age group in each event.

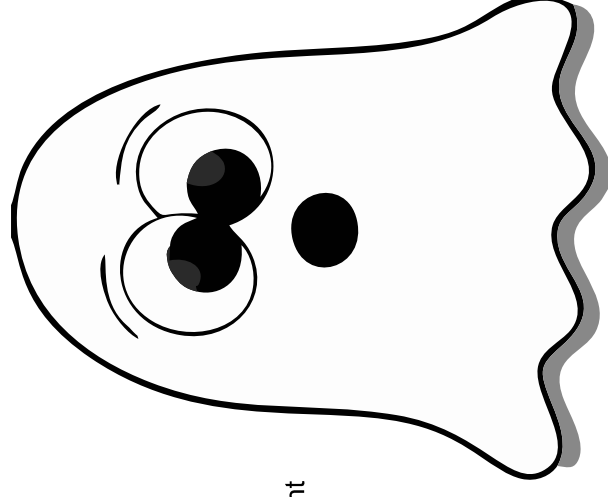
3. Meet Procedures

3.1 Electronic entry file to be emailed to the competition organiser. - chairman@barrowasc.co.uk

3.2 Individual paper entries to be sent in the post for the attention of the Janette Ralph c/o Barrow ASC as per Section 1.18

3.3 Draft programme will be posted on the club website. <http://www.barrowasc.co.uk>



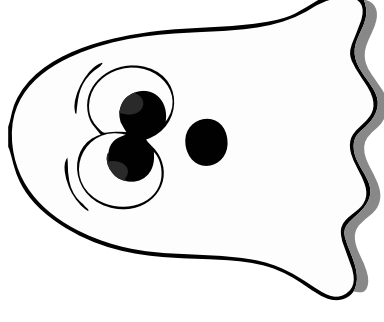
- 3.4 Each club Competition Secretary to check the accuracy of the entries to allow any necessary corrections to be made. The final gala programmes will be produced as a result of any corrections that are received.
- 3.5 Withdrawals will be accepted until the start of the warm up for each session. There will be no refund of entry fees.
- 3.6 Any withdrawals after the closing deadline will result in heats being swum with empty lanes.
- 3.7 Any swimmer who has previously withdrawn can be reinstated before the appropriate closing deadline without penalty.
- 3.8 Heat Start Lists will be made available to clubs as soon as possible after the commencement of the warm-up of each session.
- 3.9 Swimmers must present themselves to the Competitors Stewards one event prior to the one in which they are competing. **It is the swimmer's responsibility to be at the start in time for their race.**
- 3.10 The time of warm up for the session will be 12:45pm unless otherwise notified prior to the meet.
- 3.11 A strobe light is available on the timing system.

4 Spectators and Coaches

- 4.1 Spectators will be allowed subject to local restrictions and COVID-19 advice, Final decision on spectators will be made 7 days prior to the gala. Entry will be £4.00, this includes seated areas and café.
- 4.2 Coaches passes can be purchased, charged at £5.00 per coach and can be purchased at a ratio of 1 pass per 10 swimmers up to a maximum of 4 for each club.
- 4.3 All coaches must hold current DBS and Safeguarding certificates, each club may be asked to provide a signed declaration from the clubs welfare officer to confirm this is the case.

- 4.4 Meet / Heat sheets will be available to purchase at the end of the warm-up priced at £0.50..

- 5.2 Colorado 'Gen 7' Timing system to be used in conjunction with SportsSystem software.
